

WATCH OUT FOR THESE TRENDING

SCAMS

SWEEPSTAKES SCAM¹



Victims are told they won a prize but must pay fees or taxes before receiving it

GRANDPARENT SCAM



Scammers pretend to be a relative in an emergency and urgently request money

ROMANCE/FRIENDSHIP SCAM



Catfishers build emotional relationships online to gain trust before requesting money or promoting fake investments

FAMILY/CAREGIVER SCAM



A trusted relative or caregiver manipulates an older adult to gain access to money, property, or assets

WRONG NUMBER TEXTS



A seemingly innocent text conversation develops into pressure to invest in fraudulent investment schemes

EMAIL EXTORTION



Scammers claim they hacked your computer and threaten to expose personal info unless paid

TOLL ROAD SCAM



Fake texts claim unpaid toll fees and direct victims to fraudulent payment websites

JURY DUTY SCAM



Impersonators claim you missed jury duty and demand immediate payment to avoid arrest

DIGITAL ARREST



Scammers pose as law enforcement, claiming you are under investigation and demanding payment to avoid arrest

HOME REPAIR SCAM



Fraudsters offer repair services, collect payment upfront, and perform poor-quality work (or none at all)

TV/RADIO AD SCAM



Fake advertisements promote services such as credit repair or reverse mortgages, then disappear after receiving payment

RECOVERY SCAM



Criminals promise to recover lost money or assets for a fee but provide no legitimate assistance
